Scratches & Rusting

A note about Scratches

From the first use, your sink will scratch. This is not a defect or flaw, but a natural part of the aging process. These marks are most apparent over the first few months of use. Over time these will blend in and become an overall patina. No matter the brand or model of a sink, this aging process remains the same.

A note about Rusting

Stainless steel products cannot rust on their own. Rusting is caused by foreign matter on the surface of the sink which has oxidized. This could be from a steel utensil, pot, acidic foods left in the sink, or tiny particles left behind from the use of steel wool.
